BACKGROUND

Lung cancer remains the leading cause of cancer death worldwide, with an estimated five years overall survival of only 16%. Thanks to the technological advances, during the last ten years, different molecular alterations, responsible for the development of oncogene addicted tumors, have been identified in NSCLC. Currently, NSCLC is not considered a single entity, but as a heterogeneous disease, including molecularly defined subsets of lung tumors.

One essential point in providing optimal care to lung cancer patients is the possibility to discuss and share the diagnostic and therapeutic program in a multidisciplinary team.

The aim of the conference is to provide update on clinical cancer research in lung cancer and discuss specific topic in a multidisciplinary group, through lectures, discussion and opportunity to share opinions and experiences between speakers and attendees.
